One of the main differences between AutoCAD and other CAD programs is that AutoCAD offers the ability to view and edit the geometry of 3D objects, with all data being stored in a single file called a DWG (Drawing). The DWG file format is common across many CAD programs, which can import and export DWG files. AutoCAD is the only desktop CAD application that offers 3D rendering, animation, advanced drafting, and simulation, features which are available in the
