AutoCAD uses a client-server architecture and can run on personal computers (PCs), mobile devices, and embedded systems. AutoCAD operates on several operating systems, including Microsoft Windows and OS X (the latter requires a 64-bit installation). AutoCAD can be used as a standalone program or as a client application on a platform (e.g., Windows, OS X) designed specifically to run CAD software. The exact version of AutoCAD used for this guide is AutoCAD 2020 (Figure 1). AutoCAD is the standard in 2D drafting software for CAD and design. The latest version features integrated support for markup creation and collaboration, including text and graphics markup, point, line, polyline, and polygon fills, and page images. "Markup," as used in this article, refers to the drawing's structure information that represents its intended design. "Markup Assist," on the other hand, refers to support for users to apply, insert, and edit these structures (markup) using standard drafting commands. With markup commands, drawings are now easier to create, interact, and collaborate on. Designers can easily create and manipulate design representations, such as comps and 3D views, without having to worry about inserting drawings into other drawings.
